### 1. Application & Screening

Timeline: Week 1–2

- Submit your application via the <u>Ornge</u> <u>Careers Portal</u>.
- Complete a pre-screening questionnaire to assess qualifications.
- Applications are reviewed by the Ornge hiring team; selected candidates are contacted within 5–10 business days.

#### 2. Interview & Assessment

Timeline: Week 3-4

- Initial Interview: May be virtual or in-person, focusing on experience, motivation, and fit.
- Technical Assessment: Paramedics, pilots, and operations control centre positions include scenario-based evaluations and skills-based testing.
- Behavioural Interview: Evaluates alignment with Ornge's values and team dynamics.

## 3. Reference & Background Checks

Timeline: Week 5

- Reference checks are conducted for shortlisted candidates.
- Background checks are required for all roles.

### 4. Offer & Acceptance

Timeline: Week 6

- Successful candidates receive a formal iob offer.
- You'll be given time to review and accept, typically within 5 business days.

### 5. Onboarding & Training

Timeline: Week 7-12

- Onboarding includes orientation, safety training, and role-specific preparation.
- Critical Care Paramedics, Operations Control Centre and Pilots receive industry-leading training, including simulation and ongoing professional development.
