In a continuing effort to improve our services, we surveyed **various stakeholders**. These surveys are designed to obtain information that will help us **continually improve and respond** to identified needs.

- When surveyed about the types of calls ÷ where respondents interacted with Ornge, approximately 35% indicated for transfer between a hospital and airport/helipad, 18% indicated for on-scene or modified scene response, and **47%** indicated for both.
- Respondents indicated that the Ornge aircraft would arrive to the scene or modified scene location prior to their departure about half of the time.

Feedback identified areas where Ornge can improve their service, including:



Reliance on land paramedic services for transport between hospital/airport



Resource Constraints



Communication among paramedics, communications centre and hospital staff
